Steer Weigh-in and Identification

The steer weigh-in and identification for the Lafayette County Fair Meat Animal Auction has been set.

Date: Saturday, December 19, 2020

Time: 9:00 A.M. – Noon

Location: Lafayette County Fairgrounds

Cost: \$3.00 per RFID Tag

No BULLS ACCEPTED! Minimum weight to be eligible to sell at the Lafayette County Fair Auction is 500 lbs. (on December 19th) and maximum weight for all beef steers and Holstein Steers is 900 lbs. (December 19th). The breed will be determined at the weigh-in.

Youth exhibiting bred and owned market steers will be responsible to present a registration paper at the Lafayette County Fair if they would like to compete for the Bred & Owned Champion. **What is Bred & Owned?** By definition: A bred & owned animal is one where the junior member owned the dam (cow) of the calf at the time the calf was conceived. The junior member must be listed as the breeder, first and continuous owner on the registration certificate (presented at check-in at the Lafayette County Fair).

Please make sure you view any changes in the 2021 Fair Book this spring by visiting www.LafayetteCountyFair.org.

Only those youth exhibitors, who complete an online class of Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA), will be eligible to sell in the 2021 Meat Animal Auction. State guidelines specify that a 4-H member must be in at least 3rd grade to exhibit an animal.
