### Homemade Wine Judging

Rules:

- All wines will be judged at room temperature.
- Bring two bottles—one for display in cooler and one for judging.
- All entries must be submitted in transparent bottles free of any identification of wine maker.
- Please use new corks, points may be deducted if cork fragments are in wine.
- Bring your wine to Lafayette County Fair Office on **Tuesday, July 9.**
- Drop or mail entry form and \$5.00 for each individual entry to the below address no later than Tuesday, July 9.
