Safety

- All participants are required to wear a neck brace.
- All vehicles must have roll cages.
- All appliances need to be removed prior to entering Fair Grounds. **NO GLASS – PERIOD!**
- **NO ONE UNDER 18** allowed in the pit area. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- All drivers and anyone purchasing a pit pass must sign a release form Sunday.
- **ONLY** authorized persons in the infield! You will **NOT** cross the track until all the events are finished. **NO** spectators in the infield whatsoever! Do not stand in the gateway/entrance to the track.
- You cannot cut through the infield to catch a gauntlet or pass/catch cars.
- You **MUST** remove any and all items and place them in the dumpster (tires, rods, metal, etc). If not taken care of you **WILL** be contacted to remove them.

Gauntlet

Vehicle - Must be a van – Regular size or mini van. **No large van type vehicles** (Like a UPS Van). No Pickup trucks. Gauntlet vehicles must have 5 Point harness. **Gauntlet vehicles must have roll cages.** Driver's door should be welded or chained shut. May have one passenger. Passengers must also have 5-point harness. **All occupants must wear a helmet and a neck brace.** All vehicles must have a driver's side window net. If you have a fire suit please wear it! Passengers may have squirt guns with water or throw tomatoes, eggs, oranges, or other perishable non-harmful food products. Absolutely **NO** bolt on grill guards, angle iron guard rail or other steel pieces. Tires with no rims as a grill guard are acceptable. The driver's personal safety is our number one priority. Please have fuel tanks in a secure and safe location. All vehicles will be inspected!

Pursuit Vehicles – 3 Pursuit vehicles per gauntlet race. Any size car allowed. Vans (Regular or mini) and pick up trucks are allowed – ½ ton – **NO four-wheel drive working.** No passengers allowed. **All drivers must wear a helmet and a neck brace.** Driver's side window nets and 5-point harness are mandatory. **Roll cages are mandatory.** Please have fuel tanks located in a safe and secure location. Vehicles will be inspected. Absolutely **NO** bolt on grill guards, angle iron guard rail, or other steel pieces. Tires with no rims as a grill guard are acceptable.

Races will consist of four laps. **Window nets are mandatory for both vehicles!**

Payout – (For each race)

\$150.00 to winner(s)

\$120.00 to loser(s)

If van wins they get \$150.00. If van loses/gets wrecked or gets stopped they get \$120.00

Pursuit vehicles split \$150.00 if they stop the van. They split \$120.00 if they do not.

Crash Cars

Any vehicle allowed cars, vans, trucks (2 wheel drive only) 5-point harness and drivers side window nets are mandatory. **Neck brace and helmets are required. No passengers!** Fire suits are recommended. **Roll cages are mandatory.** Crash cars will run first and are eligible for Pursuit vehicles etc. Laps will consist of eight forward and two backward.

Payout – 1st - \$100.00

2nd - \$80.00
3rd - \$70.00
4th - \$50.00
5th - \$40.00

Trailer Races

Vehicle – May be a car, van, or truck (may be 4 wheel drive) up to ¾ ton. **5 point harness and driver’s side window net are mandatory. Helmet and neck brace required.** Fire suit is recommended however **NOT** required. **Roll cages are required.** Absolutely no bolt on grill guards, angle iron guard rail, or other steel pieces. Tires with no rims as a grill guard are acceptable. Please have fuel tanks in a safe and secure location. Vehicles will be inspected!

Trailer – May be boat, camper, or any light trailer. **No heavy steel trailers,** manure spreaders, etc. Must have any or all glass, appliances, junk, etc. removed before the races. Vehicles will be inspected.

If we have a lot of trailer racers, it may be possible that we will have two races.

Hitches – Ball type, pin type, may use safety or log chains.

Payout – 1st - \$300.00
2nd - \$150.00
3rd - \$100.00
4th - \$75.00
5th - \$50.00

Race Details:

Races will start promptly at 6:00pm. Race order is: Crash Cars, Gauntlets, Trailer Races

Entry fees for first race \$15.00 and the are rest \$10.00 each. Pit passes are \$10.00.

Payout can be picked up on the stage immediately following the completion of the trailer races. Scorers will stay there for 45 minutes after the last race. If payout is not picked up you can pick it up at the fair office on Monday. After that, you will forfeit your payout.

You may have your vehicle in all three events, **but must specify before any races begin.**

Sign up and registration starts at 3:30 pm and ends at 5:30 p.m. No exceptions! We need time to inspect all vehicles before the races begin. Pit gate will close at 6:00 p.m. No one is allowed to enter the pits after 6:00 p.m. No refunds.
