Hello again fair friends. Here's some more info for you.

1.) Attached is the final schedule for animals. This includes show days, times, checkin info and more. Please read it carefully, animal exhibitors. This sheet is VERY important for you!

2.) Auction exhibitors: this year the auction will feature a large screen with an image of you and your fair animal. Please take a picture with your auction animal and send it to [abneybrodie@gmail.com](mailto:abneybrodie@gmail.com). We will need the picture by July 6th, so we can get the PowerPoint ready.

3.) Anyone coming on the grounds July 13-19 will need to sign a waiver and wear a wristband. Minors will need parent signatures as well. You will not be allowed on the grounds without it. Please keep this in mind, so you save some extra time for waivers and wristbands during fair week. It is a one time waiver, so once you take care of it, you're set for the week.

4.) Barns WILL be shut down each night. There are strict hours for opening and closing of the grounds each day. It is on the schedule attached. Be prepared and schedule accordingly.

5.) Absolutely no loitering in the barns or in large groups on the grounds. We are thankful that we can have some sort of fair this year, so let's all keep social distancing in mind at the fair.

6.) Clothing exhibitors: Lisa Carpenter sent your schedule out earlier this week. It is attached as well. Please review and make sure everything looks correct. Remember foods and clothing (juniors) is July 8th at the MultiPurpose Building by the County Shop.

7.) Barn stall assignments will be through your organization now. Let your leader or advisor know what you need for stalls/space for each animal you're bringing.
